Law amending the Law on the Central Person
(Allocation of new Social Security number of persons who experience themselves as belonging to the other sex)

§ 1

The Law on the Central Person register see. National Decree Order no. 5 of 9 January 2013, as amended by § 10 of Act no. 494 of 21 May 2013 § 1 of the Law no. 622 of 12 June 2013 and the Law no. 311 of 29 March 2014 is amended as follows:

1 In § 3, after paragraph. 5 new subsection:

"Paragraph. 6 The Economy- and Ministry of Interior issue upon receiving a written request a new security number to a person who experiences as to belong to the other sex. The allocation of a new personal registry number is subject to the delivery of a written declaration that the desire for the new personal identity is based on a sense of belonging to the other sex, and to the written confirmation of the application after a reflection period of 6 months from the time of application. It is a further condition that the person at the time of application is the age of 18."

Subsection. 6 and 7 becomes paragraph. 7 and 8.

§ 2

Subsection. 1 This Act shall come into force on 1 September 2014.

Subsection. 2 For persons who before the adoption of these rules have applied for permission to carry a name which denotes the opposite sex, for permission to get the gender designation X in the passport or permission for castration for sex change, the period mentioned in the CPR Act § 3, paragraph. 6, second paragraph, as inserted by this Act § 1, no. 1, from the time of submission of application thereof. If someone applied for several of the authorizations referred, that period of time for the first submitted application is considered.

The law does not apply to the Faeroe Islands and Greenland, but may by Royal Decree come into force in Greenland with the changes the conditions prevailing in Greenland.
