- **Pay Transparency Directive (2023/970):** Exploring the mechanisms that require employers to be more open about pay levels and structures, helping close gender-based pay gaps and enforce the principle of equal pay for equal work.
- **Directive on Combating Violence Against Women and Domestic Violence (2024/1385):** A look at EU-wide protections addressing online harassment, hate speech, and gender-based violence.
- **Key CJEU Jurisprudence:** Unpacking recent EU case law, e.g., [Commission v Hungary \(C-769/22\)](#), which clarifies how fundamental protections based on 'sex' can extend to gender identity.
