Every year on March, 31st the trans community is celebrating the **Transgender Day of Visibility – TdoV**. This year, we are proud and thrilled to bring to the front the **1st Balkan Trans Intersex march** organised by our members [Trans Net Balkan](#), [Trans Aids](#) and [Spektra](#) in Zagreb.

Threatened and at risk by the growing right wing presence, TGEU decided to support the safety of trans people. Through the help of different organisations and institutions, including the Human Rights Commissioner of the Council of Europe, [the LGBTI Intergroup at the European Parliament](#), [Amnesty International](#), [Human Rights Watch](#), reaching out has pushed the Croatian Interior Minister to commit to ensuring a safe and enabling environment for the upcoming march.

The march will close the 5th **Transposium**, which gathers every year more than 60 local trans and gender diverse activists from the Balkans.
